

Rules and Regulations for Entry

Tournament dates: Please make a note of these (all timings subject to draw size)

Main Draws: Saturday 16th June - Sat 29th & Sun 30th September 2018

Finals: Weekend of 29th & 30th September

Closing Date for Entries: Sunday 10th June 2018

General Rules:

- 1) All matches will be played in accordance with the rules of tennis and the LTA Code of Conduct.
- 2) All matches will be TWO sets with a 10 point tie-break deciding the match in the event that it is a set all. This applies in all rounds including the final.
- 3) In the event of a dispute, the decision of the joint referees will be final.

Arranging Matches:

- **4)** It is the responsibility of <u>BOTH</u> players to arrange their match by the date shown on the draw sheet.
- 5) Early Rounds will have approximately 2 weeks to complete each round with the later rounds having approximately 1 week (subject to the number of entries received)
- 6) The player (s) bracketed top is responsible for making initial contact and offering 3 reasonable dates to play the match – however see point 4 for Arranging Matches.
- 7) If no arrangement has been made, it will be assumed that the match will be played on the actual play by date. Court surface to be mutually agreed or decided by a coin toss. Court fees should be shared.
- 8) If the match is not played by the play by date, the player bracketed top will automatically go through to the next round. Bottom bracketed player must notify organisers (at least 1 week prior to the play by date) if no contact has been made.

Winning players are responsible for writing the match result on the board

Please ensure you complete all details on the form in full including the name of your doubles partner where appropriate. (Partners must complete and sign the relevant entry form and also play the entry Fee)
